Call to Order

Mike called the meeting to order with the pledge and prayer by Andy.

Approval of Minutes

Review of Claims and Account Reconciliation

Motion by Andy to introduce and table Ordinance 2022-02. Motion was 2nd by Bruce. Motion carried 4-0.

Mark then presented **Rate Ordinance 2022-03** for board consideration. Mark reviewed the ordinance and that a hearing will be held on May 2^{nd} . Rate will stay the same with the new project.

Motion to introduce and table Ordinance 2022-03 by Bruce. Motion was 2nd by Leon. Motion carried 4-0.

Mark presented a Resolution for the ARPA and Subrecipient agreement for the board. Resolution 2022-03

Engineering Reports

We performed the Liberty Center asphalt walk-thru today. Murray connection is still waiting on REMC.

We have no new pay apps from VTF. Pre-closing for phase 2 is May 19th with closing in June of 2022.

Craigville construction will start in July 2022.

April 2023 is the final completion date for the system and May is the full rate deadline with restoration in May/June.

Phase 3 – we have resubmitted the project to SRF this week for both Tocsin and Kingsland.

Leon asked Ryan to resubmit the insurance info on cost of grinder pumps to Tom Neuenschwander.

Andy asked about controls. Ryan commented that the control panels are here and coming along now.

Superintendent Report

Lewis submitted a written report to the board and is included in the record. Lewis mentioned that May 6th is the drop-dead completion date.

Lewis needs a bond to accept cash and Nate commented he will get info from Tom for the bond and to get that completed.

Allen Shaw is not off the project, and we need to see about a new inspector in the interim.

Lewis commented that Barry Scherer has since retired from the Adams County RSD due to medical reasons and wanted to publicly thank him for saving us issues with the electrical on project 1.

Board Comments

Mark commented that Craigville is moving forward and wish we could be done with phase 1 before the start of phase 2.

Public Comments

Paul Morgan asked about why he can't connect to the system if they are sending out the \$95 bills.

Mark – this was a combination of the part shortage and delivery issues. When the district established the rate ordinance the schedule was set for the full rate to begin on January 1st 2022. Since the rate ordinance established the terms for the payment of the bond the board was forced to comply and institute the rates. Simply the board didn't have a choice and was compelled to establish the rates even after they delayed more than 3 months.

Paul - it is just crazy with the bill and no recourse.

Andy - we have bank statements that show evidence that VTF has done their work and shown damages as a result.

Paul - How long till this can be connected?

Mark - plan is the May 6th for connections.

Paul - who can connect this?

Lewis – the contractor list and specifications are up on the website. <u>www.wellsrsd.com</u> and the information will be mailed out with the connection notice.

Nick Thomas - What is the purpose of the sewer?

Mike - Indiana is listed as having the worst waterways in the US according to EPA.

Nick – City of Bluffton pays how much and dropping these systems all across the county. I bought my house because it was not in the City. What is my option here?

Mark – Those areas were all identified by the county health department as having concentrations of sewage entering the waterways of the county. The state just recently changed its exemption rules, but if your system was not permitted it would still not receive an exemption.

Nick – I don't feel your prices are fair and your contractors are out of control. How can you be 4- months behind? Why can't the contractors get this done? There needs to be a better way to opt out.

Dan Schreiber – I live just north of Liberty Center. When will they be doing yard restoration? I am concerned about the work correcting the damage in the yard and the service tap up to the tank.

Lewis - you will want to keep the soil pile so you can use that to fill the old septic tank void.

Dan asked if they had a date of his system.

Nate responded that if the system discharges it is not compliant and would not have been eligible for an exemption.

Patricia Holly - this whole thing started with a threat. If I don't connect you will condemn my house.

Mark – Wells County is late to the game and the sewer district was a response to a suit brought against the county for failure to act on septic failures.

Patricia - Why the threat?

Mark – The county is full of illegal discharging systems. The state law forces the county to act on these violations. This is a board of volunteers who didn't make the laws up to threaten you.

Patricia asked about the Murray storm sewer system and lath in her yard.

Nate offered to review it with her tomorrow as he was managing that project.

Motion to adjourn – Bruce, motion 2nd by Andy. Meeting adjourned. 4-0
